International Commercial Terms

The Incoterms® rules are the terms of trade for the sale of goods. They provide specific guidance to individuals participating in the import and export of global trade. The ICC (International Chamber of Commerce) publish, maintain, and develop the Incoterm rules.

The important fundamentals of the Incoterms® rules are the basic roles and responsibilities of seller and buyer, delivery, risk, and the relationship between the Incoterms® rules and the contracts surrounding a typical contract of sale for export/import and also, where appropriate, for domestic sales.
